- Team size should be a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5. All submissions must be original work; plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- Teams must be present on the day of the event to present their ideas in person. Final decisions made by the judges are binding and final.

ELIGIBILITY :

- Open to undergraduate and postgraduate students.
- Participants from any stream or course can apply, provided they meet the above team composition rules.
- Individual entries are not allowed; only teams can participate.

REGISTRATION PROCESS :
